Now ask your mother, grandmother, or elder to identify his or her patron saint. Why was she/he named after that patron saint? What symbols or markers exist that help us recognize that particular saint?

4. **Ngai’an yan hafa taimanu un selebra este na nubena?**

When and how is the devotion and novena to the patron saint celebrated?

5. **Maayek este na santos para espesiatmente i fan gineha mona yan proteksion para i lina’la-niha. Kao guaha promesa para este na patrona? Hafa nesisidat-mu para un komple este na promesa?**
